
DEMOLITION QUICK UPDATE

Following the previous high demolition activity weeks the market seems to be tempering as many End Buyers are waiting and watching rather than jumping in. Bangladesh managed to secure larger LDT tonnages at impressive prices,

secure larger LDT tonnages at impressive prices, but some mid-week reversals on steel prices omens lower price levels on any subsequent sale. India is keeping up with market's high prices, but remains the lowest placed of the sub-continent destinations for another week. Pakistan has been on top of the sub-continent market lately, but a rampant Bangladesh and Pakistani End Buyers' filled plots, unsurprisingly slows the local market down.
