

Last week Ship recycling market saw a lot of interest and subcontinent players engaged firmly to take advantage of the momentum. Bangladesh remains at the top of the market

followed by Pakistan buyers who had lost some tonnage in the last weeks, but started to raise prices more in an effort to catch up and in some cases for the right ships even slightly above Bangladesh. India is steadily improving and competing well, we see they managed to secure some good tonnages over the last week. Turkey remains steady.
